Reported Speech Reporting 'wh' questions.

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Let's imagine that the man who is listening to the man and woman goes home and tells his wife what the woman had asked. He would say: The woman asked the man how much he had paid for the hilsa.



Let's report what Gopal's wife asked him. -> Gopal's wife <u>asked</u> him why his face was half-shaven.



-> Gopal's wife <u>wanted to</u> <u>know</u> what the matter with him was and why he was smearing himself with ash.

Let's look at the 'wh' questions once again:

Direct Speech Question (DSQ)-1. The woman said to the man, "How much did you pay for the hilsa?"

Reported Speech (RS) The woman asked the man how much he had paid for the hilsa.

2.Gopal's wife said to him, "Why <u>is your</u> face half shaven?" RS Gopal's wife asked him why <u>his</u> face <u>was</u> half -shaven. 3. Gopal's <u>wife said to him</u>, "What's the matter with you? Why are you smearing <u>yourself</u> with ash?"

Gopal's wife asked him what the matter with <u>him</u> was. Why he was smearing <u>himself</u> with ash.

What changes do we see?

RS

- removed the speech marks and the question mark-'?'
 -added the reporting verb 'asked'
- changed the verb from (back shifting)->present tense
 ->past ->past perfect tense- 'is' &'are'-> was, 'did...pay'
 ->had paid -changed pronouns -'you' -> he, him, 'yourself'-> himself- inverted the position >< of the 'to be verb' and the pronoun/noun
