

Guidelines for Skill Test to be conducted against ADVT. NO. AEES/01/2017 and its Addendum

The Skill Test will be conducted to broadly evaluate the competency of the candidate in the following aspects:

1. Subject knowledge and teaching ability
2. Communication Skills
3. Confidence and Poise

The candidate shall be evaluated on various aspects such as (among others):-

- a) Accuracy
- b) Logical thinking
- c) Use of examples/ illustrations
- d) Time management
- e) Language proficiency
- f) Creativity, etc.

Sr No.	Post	Instructions	Time allotted
1.	PGTs, TGTs and PRTs (Scholastic subjects)	The candidates have to make a presentation / Classroom teaching on the following areas: 1. Topics from the subject / discipline against which the candidate has applied pertaining to the NCERT syllabus, as applicable. 2. Any open ended topic for creative thinking.	1. Preparation for the presentation / Classroom teaching: - 15 minutes. 2. Presentation of Subject matter: - 10 minutes Creative Thinking: - 5 minutes
2.	Prep Teachers	The candidates have to make a presentation / (Classroom teaching) on a topic pertaining to the ECCEd syllabus or equivalent as prescribed by NCTE.	1. Preparation for the presentation / Classroom teaching: - 15 minutes. 2. Presentation / Classroom teaching: 15 minutes.
3.	Special Educators	The candidates have to prepare and present a case- study on a given situation / case pertaining to the special children / inclusive education.	1. Preparation for the presentation: - 15 minutes. 2. Presentation: 15 minutes.
4.	JHTs	The candidates would be asked to translate a given matter from English to Hindi and vice-versa. The candidates are also expected to explain / discuss the matter / content of the translated version.	Presentation / performance: 15 minutes
5.	PRT (Music)	The candidates have to perform (live) vocal or instrumental in front of the evaluation committee. Musical instruments (Tabla, Harmonium etc.) can be provided at the test centre.	Presentation / performance: 15 minutes
6.	TGT (Art)	The candidates have to prepare live a drawing / sketch / painting on the topic given to the candidate, by the evaluation committee. Note: Painting / drawing material has to be brought by the candidates.	Presentation / performance: 15 minutes
7.	PETs	The candidates have to present a mock teaching session of any sports / games activity to be allotted by the evaluation committee / specialization of the candidate	Presentation / performance: 15 minutes
8.	Librarian	The candidates have to present a mock library session with special emphasis on development of reading skills in front of the evaluation committee.	Presentation / performance: 15 minutes

Note: Instructions for Sr. No. 1, 2, 3 and 4:

The following materials will be provided:

1. Topic Basket, containing cards with topics.
2. Creative Idea Basket containing random pictures or story lines / materials.
3. NCERT books / text material.
4. For PGT (Computer Science), Computer Science textbooks/ text materials by CBSE (class IX to XII) may be provided.
4. Computers (if needed).
