2. Before summer vacation while issuing the transfer orders, care may be taken that employee may get ample time for settlement during the vacation.

## **Committee recommendations for Request transfer**

In addition to the existing guidelines, the following are recommended

- 1. The vacancy position of different schools may be displayed in the AEES website.
- 2. Transfer if any, should be implemented at the end of the academic session.
- 3. National / AEES awardees may be given preference.
- 4. Newly recruited / promoted staff may be transferred on request only after completing minimum three years of service at the existing place.
