(A) **Classes: Balvatika-1, 2 & 3(all days)**

Boys and Girls

Refer to the picture

1. Dress -

a) T-Shirt:

- a. Colour – red
- b. Design/pattern - Half sleeves with dark navy-blue collar and two white stripes on collar and two dark navy-blue & two white stripes on sleeves.
- c. Quality – polyester cotton (PC peanut) (hosiery)
- d. Fabric thickness – 220 GSM

b) Shorts:

- a. Colour - Blackish navy-blue
- b. Design/pattern - without hook, back elastic
- c. quality – polyester viscose (PV), concord quality

2. Hair cut-

- a. Boy - Neat and short presentable haircut.
- b. Girl- Single plait/braid for long hair/two pony tails for short hair with navy-blue hair rubber band (elastic ties).

Note: Cottonhair rubber bands (elastic ties) must be used; plastic items must be avoided.
Fashion trends are not permitted.

3. Footwear-

- a) Black shoes with Velcro and navy-blue socks with two white stripes.
- b) Rain Footwear (permitted only during monsoon): Only black flat sandals with flaps/floater-pattern is permitted as part of the uniform for the students. Flip-flops is not permitted.

4. Belt-No Belt.

5. Winter garments-

- a. Dark navy-blue sleeveless/full-sleeved sweater in 'V' cut neck with:
 - Two white stripes on the neck and two white stripes on the sleeves.
 - Dark navy-blue blazer is permitted.
 - Dark navy-blue cardigans (front-open sweater) are permitted for girls.
- b. Dark navy-blue trousers/shorts
- c. Dark navy-blue cap/ scarf is permitted to cover the head. Fashion trends are not allowed.

(Sweatshirts with hoods and shawls are not permitted)

6. Logo: Embroidered logo of AEEES on the left side (on the chest) above the arm-hole level of the t-shirt/sweater/cardigan/blazer. The proportion of the logo should be maintained.

Note: Gold/Fashionable ornaments, mehndi, nail polish or any sort of cosmetics are prohibited on the school campus.

(B) Classes: I to V (Except Wednesday and Saturday).

Boys and Girls

Refer to the picture

1. Dress-

a) T-Shirt:

- a. Colour – red
- b. Design/pattern - Half sleeves, dark navy-blue collar with two white stripes on the collar and two dark navy-blue & white stripes on the sleeves.
- c. Quality – polyester cotton (PC peanut) (hosiery)
- d. Fabric thickness – 220 GSM

b) Bottoms (Girls):

- a. Design/pattern – flap-short (skorts) with back elastic
- b. Colour - Dark navy-blue
- c. Quality – polyester viscose (PV), concord quality

c) Bottom (Boys):

- a. Shorts
- b. Colour – Dark navy-blue
- c. Design/pattern - without hook, back elastic
- d. quality – polyester viscose (PV), concord quality

2. Hair cut-

- a) Boy - Neat and short presentable haircut.
- b) Girl- Single plait/braid for long hair/two ponytails for short hair with navy-blue hair rubber band (elastic ties).

Note: Cotton hair rubber bands (elastic ties) must be used; plastic items must be avoided. Fashion trends are not allowed.

3. Footwear-

- a) Black shoes with Velcro, same for boys and girls, and navy-blue socks with two white stripes.
- b) Rain Footwear (permitted only during monsoon): Only black flat sandals with flaps/floater-pattern are permitted as part of the uniform for the students/flip-flops is not permitted.

4. Belt- No Belt.

5. Winter garments-

- a. Dark navy-blue sleeveless/full-sleeved sweater in 'V' cut neck with:
 - Two white stripes on the neck and two white stripes on the sleeves
 - Dark navy-blue blazer is also permitted.
 - Dark navy-blue cardigans (front-open sweater) are permitted for girls.
- b. Dark navy-blue trousers/shorts/skorts
- c. Dark navy-blue cap/ scarf is permitted to cover the head. Fashion trends are not allowed.

(Sweatshirts with hoods and shawls are not permitted)

- 6. **Logo:** Embroidered logo of AEES on the left side (on the chest) above the arm-hole level of the t-shirt/sweater/cardigan/blazer. The proportion of the logo should be maintained.

7. Note-

Gold/Fashionable ornaments, mehndi, nail polish or any sort of cosmetics are prohibited on the school campus.

(C) Classes: VI to XII (Except: Wednesday and Saturday)

Boys and Girls

Refer to the picture

1. Dress (Girls)-

a) Shirt:

- a. Colour – stripes (as given in the picture)
- b. Front – Half-sleeves shirt with navy-blue piping on the sleeves, front open with light pink buttons and nopockets. Only 3 buttons will be open (1 collar button and the next 2 buttons), the rest will be non-openable show-buttons (the rest of the button patti will be stitched/sealed).
- c. Back - Upside down 'V' shaped pleat on the center of the box patti at the back of the shirt as given in the picture.
- d. Straight bottom seam with side slits
- e. Logo – AEES logo on the left side (on the chest) above the arm-hole level
- f. Quality – woven polyester viscose (PV)
- g. Thickness – 2/60

b) Bottoms:

- a. Regular pants with 2 pockets on the sides
- b. Colour - Navy-blue
- c. quality – polyester viscose (PV), concord quality

2. Dress (Boys)-

a) Shirt:

- a. Colour – stripes (as given in the picture)
- b. Front – Half-sleeves shirt with navy-blue piping on the sleeves, full front open with light pink buttons, witha pocket on the left side
- c. Curved bottom seam without side slits
- d. Logo – AEES logo on the pocket
- e. Quality – woven polyester viscose (PV)
- f. Thickness – 2/60

b) Bottoms:

- a. Regular pants with 2 pockets on the sides and 1 pleat on either side in the front
- b. Colour - navy-blue.
- c. quality – polyester viscose (PV), concord quality

3. Hair cut-

- a) Boy - Neat and short presentable haircut.
- b) Girl- Single high plait/braid for long hair / two pony tails for short hair with navy-blue hair rubber band (elastic ties).

Note: Cotton hair rubber bands (elastic ties) must be used; plastic items must be avoided.
Fashion trends are not allowed.

4. Footwear- (Refer to the picture)

- a. Black shoes with laces for boys and girls and navy-blue socks with two white stripes.
- b. Rain footwear (permitted only during monsoon): Only black flat sandals with flaps/floaters-pattern are permitted as part of the uniform for the students(Floaters-pattern should be uniform for the students)/Flip-flops are not permitted.

5. Belt-

Dark navy-blue nylon belt with red stripe in the middle and a brass buckle with the AEES emblem engraved on the buckle.

6. Winter garments-

- a. Dark navy-blue sleeveless/full-sleeved sweater in 'V' cut neck with:
 - Two white stripes on the neck and two white stripes on the sleeves
 - A dark navy-blue blazer is also permitted.
 - Dark navy-blue cardigans (front-open sweater) are permitted for girls.
- b. Dark navy-blue trousers.
- c. Dark navy-blue cap/scarf is permitted to cover the head. Fashion trends are not allowed. (Sweatshirts with hoods and shawls are not permitted)

- 7. Logo:** Embroidered logo of AEES on the pocket,
or in case a pocket is not available on the chest above the arm-hole level of the
shirt/sweater/cardigan/blazer.
The proportion of the logo should be maintained.

8. Note-

Gold/Fashionable ornaments, mehndi, nail polish or any sort of cosmetics are prohibited on the school campus.

(D) Classes I to XII –OnWednesday and Saturday (Boys and Girls)

(refer to the pictures):

1. T-shirt:

- a. House-wise coloured T-shirts, **without pockets**, with a collar. (Blue, Green, Red, Yellow).
- b. Quality – polyester cotton (PC peanut) (hosiery)
- c. Fabric thickness – 220 GSM

2. Bottom:

- a. Black coloured loose lower (track pants) with a thin white stripe on both sides of the lower.
- b. Quality – polyester cotton (PC)
- c. Fabric thickness – 240 GSM
- d. Weave – plain weave




3. Footwear: White coloured canvas shoes with laces.

4. Socks: Dark navy-blue socks with two white strips on it.

5. Logo: Embroidered logo of AEES on the left side (on the chest) above the arm-hole level of the T-shirts. The proportion of the logo should be maintained.

(E) Please Note:

1. The days of sports uniforms are Wednesday and Saturday. It should be followed uniformly at all the centers.
2. **Students will be allotted a HOUSE only once in class I or at the time of new admission.**
 - **The house may not be changed except in classes VI and XI.**
3. All girls with long hair should tie their hair properly in a single plait/braid.
4. All girls with short hair (not touching the shoulder) should use hair (elastic) band.
5. Hair cut – Boys should get their hair cut, which should be neat, decent and presentable (fashionable and trendy hair style is not allowed).
6. The belt should strictly be as per AEES specifications.
7. During the monsoon season, students can wear black rainproof shoes /black flat sandals with flaps.
8. During the winter season a dark navy-blue sweater or a dark navy-blue blazer.
9. Caps/scarf of dark navy-blue colour are only allowed.
10. Jacket/Jerkin/Wind cheater/Hoodies and casuals are not allowed.
11. Bathroom slippers are not allowed.
12. Gold/Fashionable ornaments, mehndi, nail polish or any sort of cosmetics are prohibited in the campus.
13. Bringing any electronic device, circlet bracelet, pebble steel, smart watch, camera, cosmetics or any other objectionable material into the school is prohibited and condemnable; such non-permitted material will be confiscated and will not be returned.
14. Students should come decently dressed during special occasions.

Note: The above guidelines must be followed uniformly and strictly by all the AEC Schools/ AE Junior Colleges.
