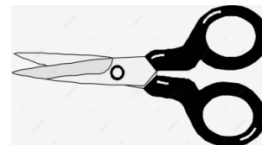

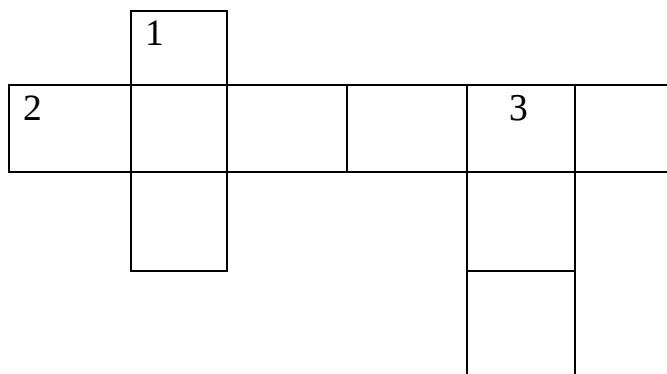

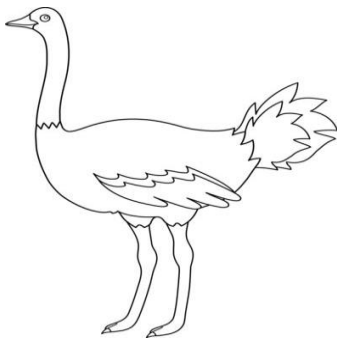

Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi, known as Mahatma Gandhi, was born on October 2, 1869, in Porbandar, a small town in Gujarat. As a child, he was shy and quiet but very curious. He loved listening to stories of courage and truth that his parents and elders told him. His father, Karamchand Gandhi, was a wise and honest man, while his mother, Putlibai, was deeply religious and kind-hearted.

One incident from Gandhi's childhood taught him the value of honesty. One day, a teacher asked students to write the spelling of the word "kettle." Young Gandhi made a mistake, but he refused to copy the correct spelling from his neighbour. His teacher scolded him, but Gandhi believed it was better to be truthful than to cheat.

Gandhi's mother also influenced him greatly. She would often fast and pray, teaching Gandhi the importance of self-discipline and compassion. These lessons shaped his life and made him the great leader he later became. Gandhi grew up to fight for India's freedom with his principles of truth and non-violence, inspiring millions around the world.
