PHRASE

The **sentence**, as we know, is a group of words that make complete sense.

Let us see the various steps that lead to a place.

The smallest part of the written English language is the letter –
A, B, C and so on.

A group of letters forms a word – great, happy, table and so on.

Phrase:

A phrase is a group of words that either has no verb or has a non-finite verb and does not make complete sense.

For example: a) Two pretty babies.

B) To sail in the ocean.

C) Ducks swimming in the pond.

In the above examples, you can see that whether the group of words is long or short, none of them contains a finite verb and none of them makes complete sense. Such groups of words are known as **phrases**.
