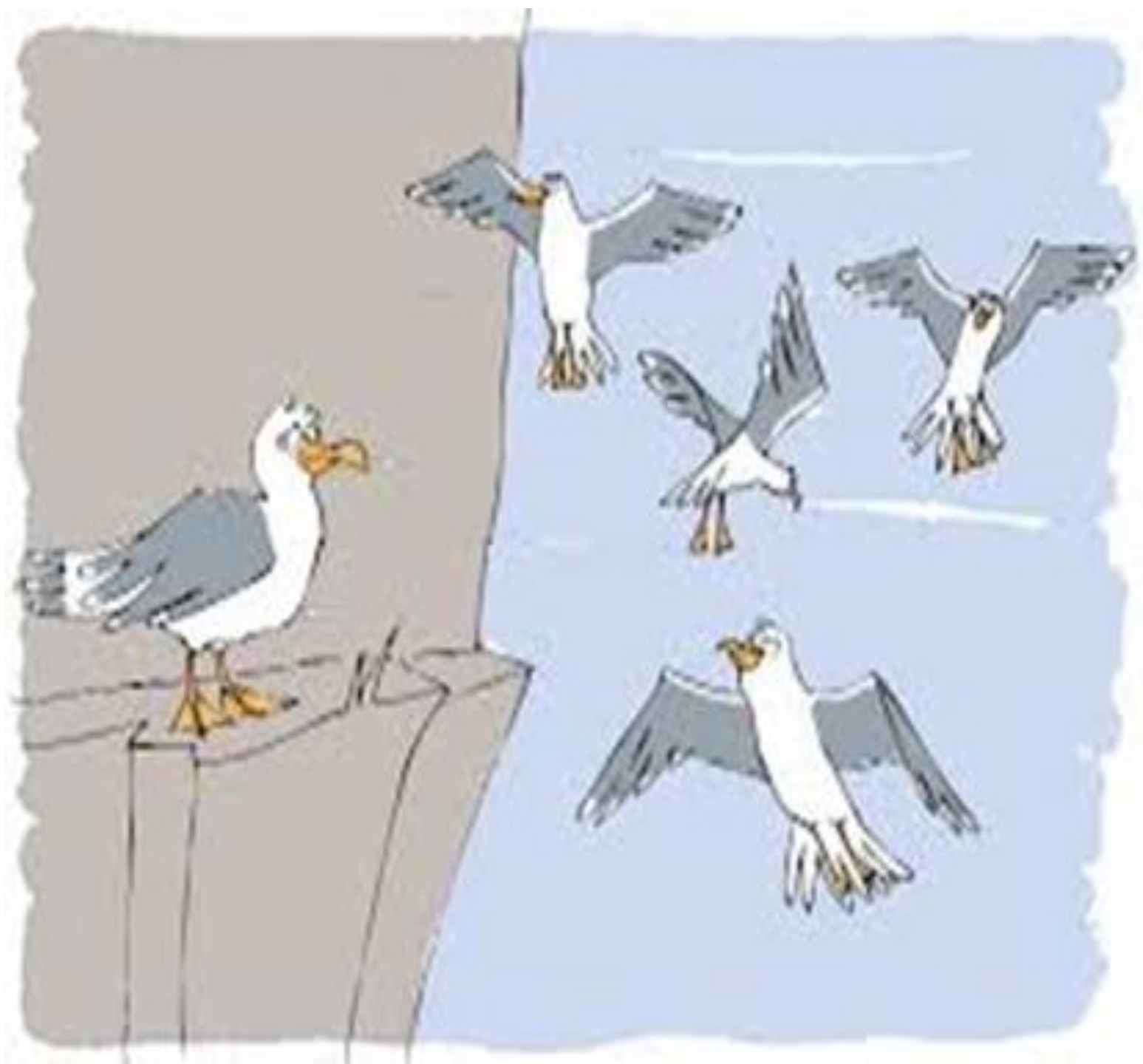


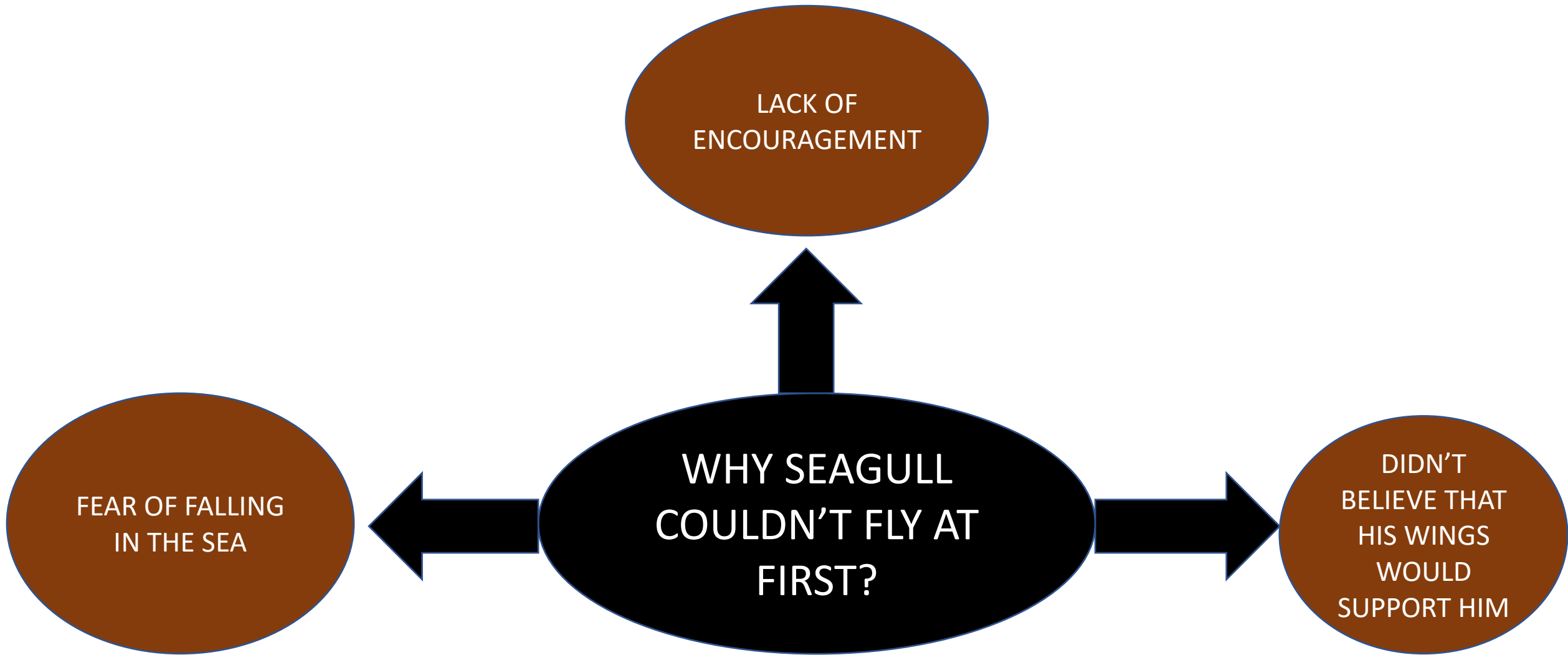

THE POOR SEAGULL

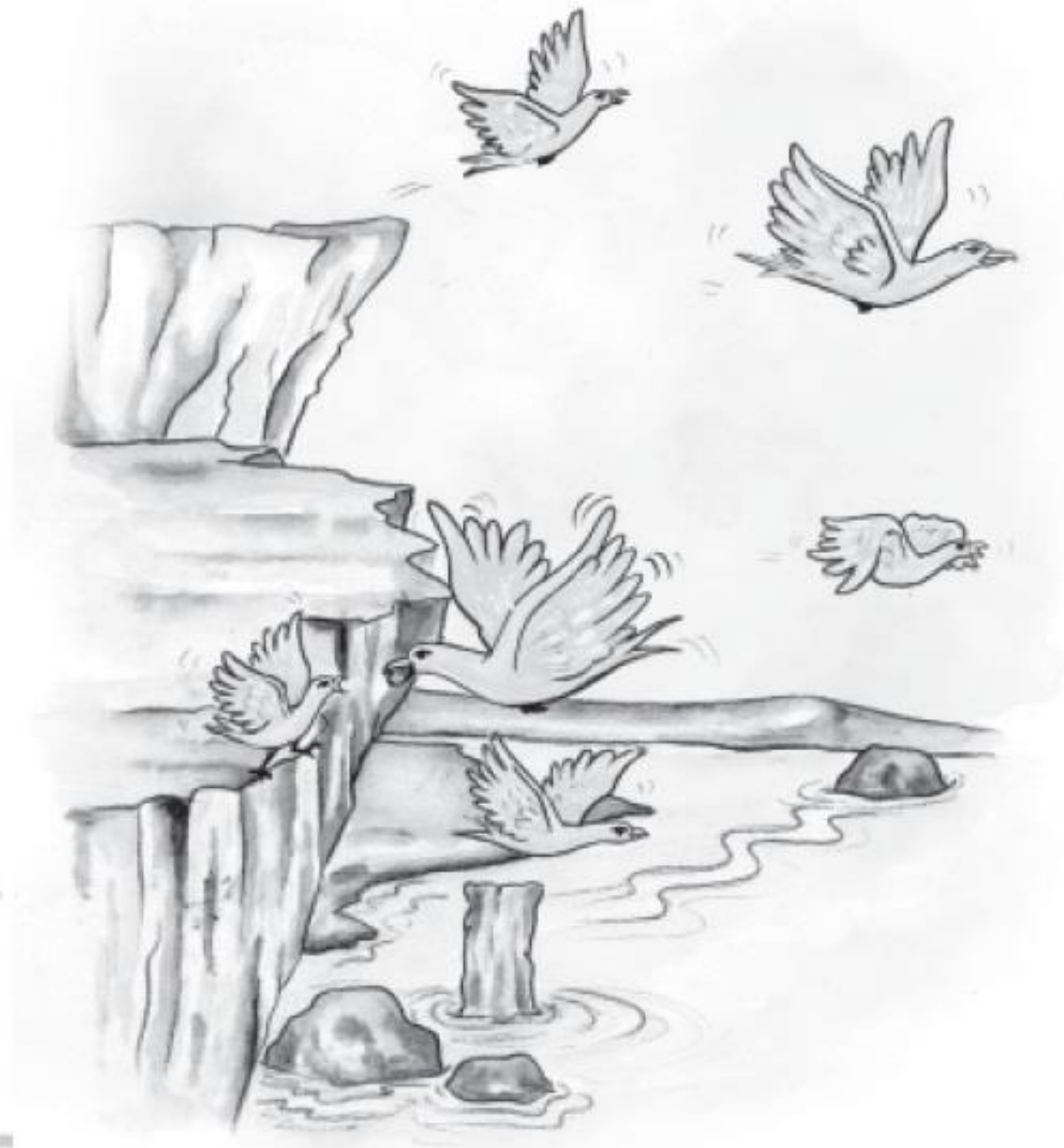
- The fear of falling down in the sea stopped the young seagull from taking his first flight.

THE FIRST FLIGHT

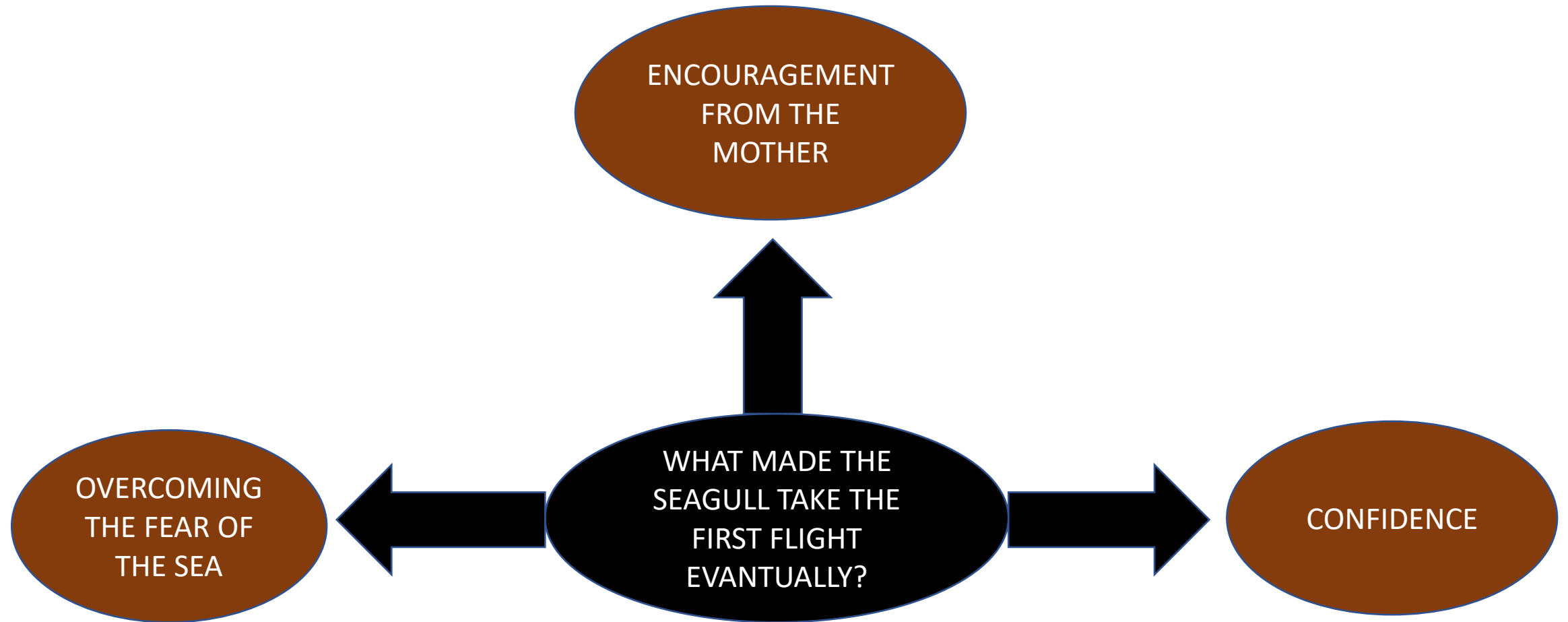
- The hungry seagull jumped at the piece of fish offered by mother.
